VI. Committee Reports

- Finance/Facilities
 - Financial Audit
 - everything is marked as a draft currently
 - page 8 Statement of Deficit
 - pension liability (PSERS) \$5.4 million
 - page 9 Statement of Activities
 - shows a loss
 - page 10 the general fund
 - this is really our fund balance
 - around \$190 thousand
 - \$121 thousand that was owed to SDOL has already been paid back
 - page 14 -
 - left: original & final budget reported to state

- middle: the actual balance
- individual line items: differences & variances
 - submission of budgets is not consistent with how audit is being done
- Student Services non academic services for students; the number went up because of the guidance counselor's salary; that position was not in the original budget that was submitted to the state
- depository insurance in the process of contacting the bank to get more information
- Rent question SACA & the financial committee work together on the rental agreement; SACA has kept the rent flat for the next 3 years
 - lease with 38 N. Ann is with SACA
 - lease with 30 N. Ann is with SACA Development
 - 5 year lease is assigned to the first year of the lease

- Hard to bring goals to the table because it's hard to know the direction of the school

VII. Old Business/New Business

- Presentation about diagnostic results i-Ready
 - School Summary green (on grade level), yellow (2 grade levels below), red (3 or more below grade level) most of pyramid is red
 - reading and math results are similar majority of students are scoring in red
 - 12th & 9th are entirely red for math
 - higher number of ELL & special education students
 - influx of students from Puerto Rico
 - math questions on state testing incorporates many areas of math skills; our high school students have not been taught this way, but our 6th graders were in elementary school which is why their schools are a little better
 - Would like to see data on the students who were here last year to measure their growth
- diagnostic administered in September, January, May; growth checks will be administered in between diagnostics
- what are we doing to improve
 - hired a certified ELA teacher
 - vocabulary strategies for all subjects
 - instructional coaching Ferg & Palow
 - Could we provide peer tutoring? Victor suggests this could help especially with the relational aspect
 - Could we provide book clubs? this could help students be more interested in books & reading
 - Armstrong employees will come into the afterschool program to tutor students
 - Do we have the resources we need to move students?
 - resources for high school students
 - training for teachers for specific strategies
 - impact of behavior & the need of mental health counseling services regular services
 - Jackie Fischer will come for intake on Friday & will provide group & individual counseling
 - SDOL has received additional funding from the state to help with the influx of EL students;
 maybe there will be a second round of funding or could we work with the district for the students we have
 - Is there a pull out for behavior (ISS)? No, but this kind of consequence does not address the misbehaviors
 - Self-care for teachers secondary stress disorder is a real thing for teachers; we do not have a lot of support for this either
 - Leadership of the school should put together a plan together for the needs of the school for mental health & ELL support
